

## Specialty Certificate Examination in Endocrinology and Diabetes 2025 Selected Examination Metrics

The 2025 SCE in Endocrinology and Diabetes was sat in November 2025 by 474 candidates of whom 152 were self-declared UK resident doctors. From 2022 'OTH' self-declared UK resident doctors are excluded from UK resident doctors' cohort. Candidates who did not declare their training details and the OTH group are reported as 'Other candidates' (322).

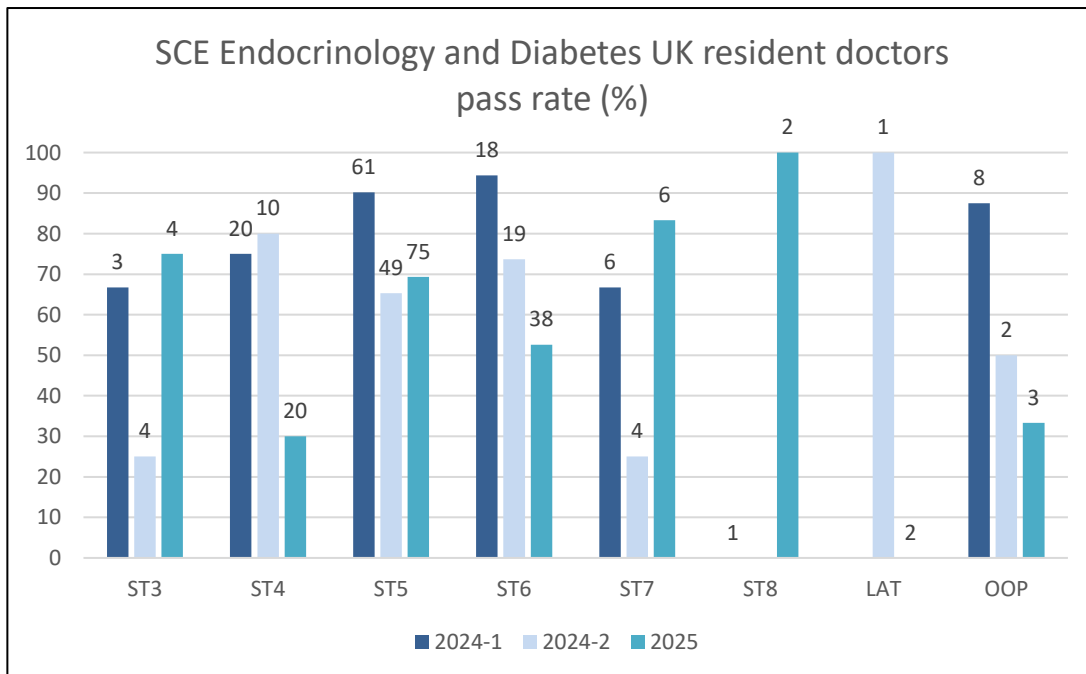
### Pass Mark

The pass mark for the 2025 examination was established by equating based on 2019 UK resident doctors' performance after excluding the OTH group. The standards of the examination were reviewed in February 2022 and the pass score was increased from 432 to **462**. All future examinations will use 462 as the passing score until the standards are reviewed by the SCE Endocrinology and Diabetes Examination Board.

For the 2025 SCE Endocrinology and Diabetes examination the pass mark was set at **462 (62% or 124/200)**.

### UK resident doctors' performance

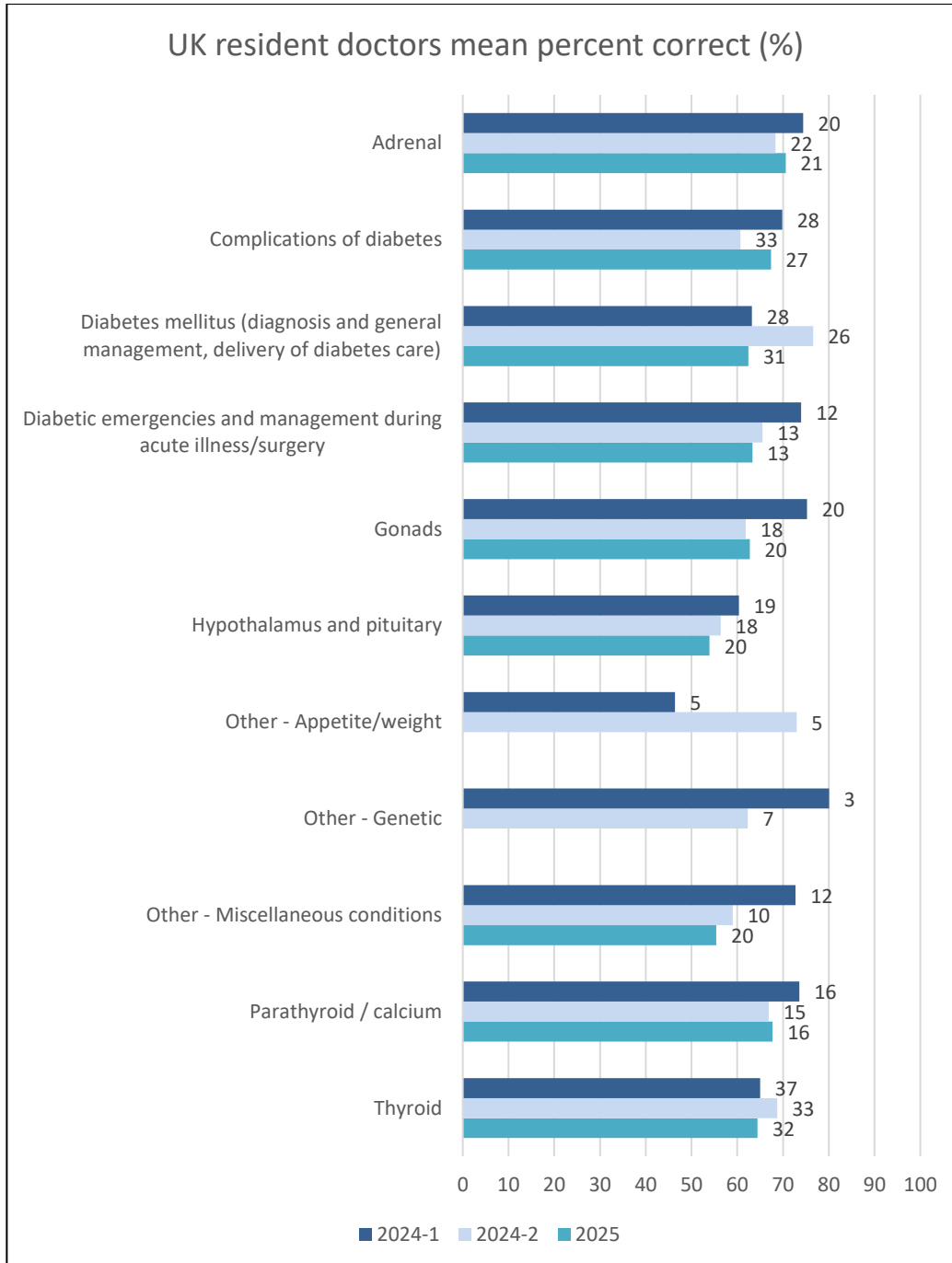
In 2025 the highest number of sitting UK resident doctors is in ST5 (75) and their pass rate is (69.3%). Overall, UK resident doctors' pass rate is 58.6% and 40.1% for all candidates.



Note: The numbers at the top of the bars are the number of resident doctors sitting

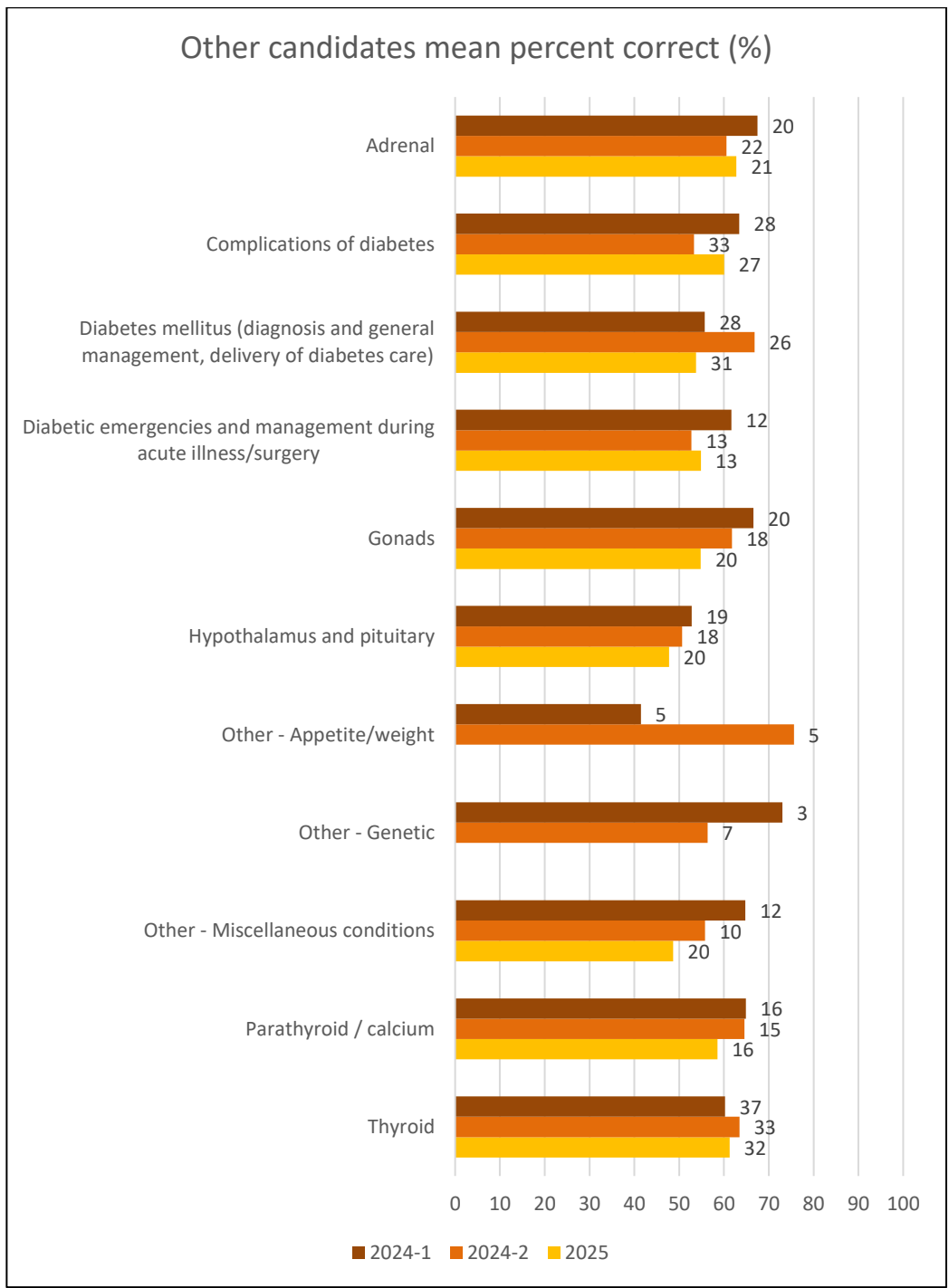
## Topic performance

In 2025 UK resident doctors have the highest percent correct in Adrenal (70.6%) and the lowest in Hypothalamus and pituitary (53.9%).

In 2025 Other candidates have the highest percent correct in Adrenal (62.8%) and the lowest in Hypothalamus and pituitary (47.7%).
