

Specialty Certificate Examination (SCE) in Medical Oncology 2025 Selected Examination Metrics

The 2025 SCE in Medical Oncology was sat in September 2025 by 240 candidates of whom 97 were self-declared UK resident doctors. From 2022 'OTH' self-declared UK resident doctors are excluded from UK resident doctors' cohort.

Candidates who did not declare their training details and the OTH group are reported as 'Other candidates' (143).

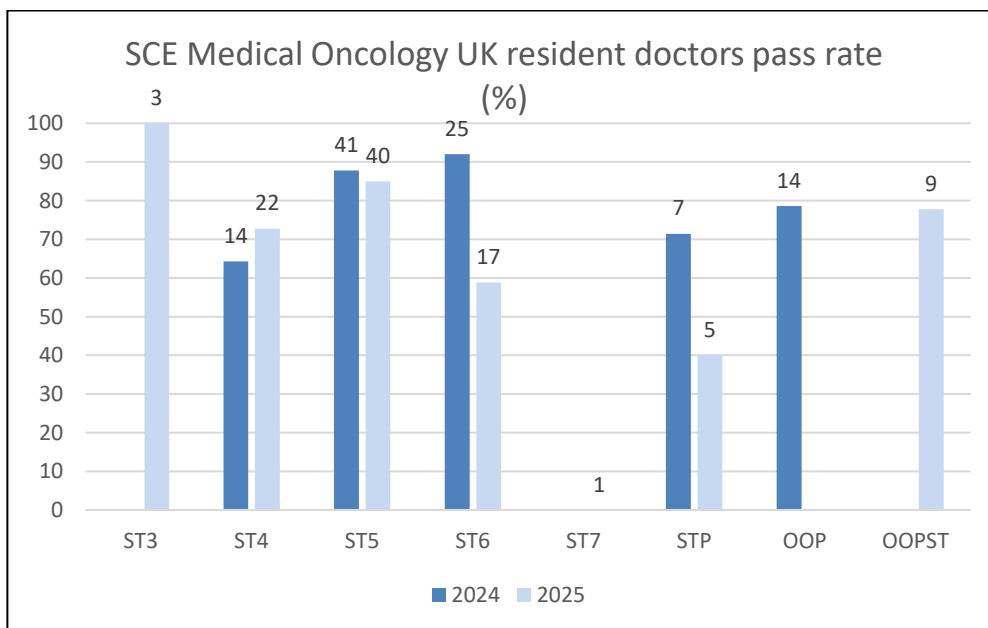
Pass Mark

The 2025 Medical Oncology examination was equated using 2019 UK resident doctors' performance, excluding OTH group, in line with all the other SCEs.

For the 2025 SCE Medical Oncology examination the pass mark was set at **371 (61.9% or 122/197)**.

UK resident doctors' performance

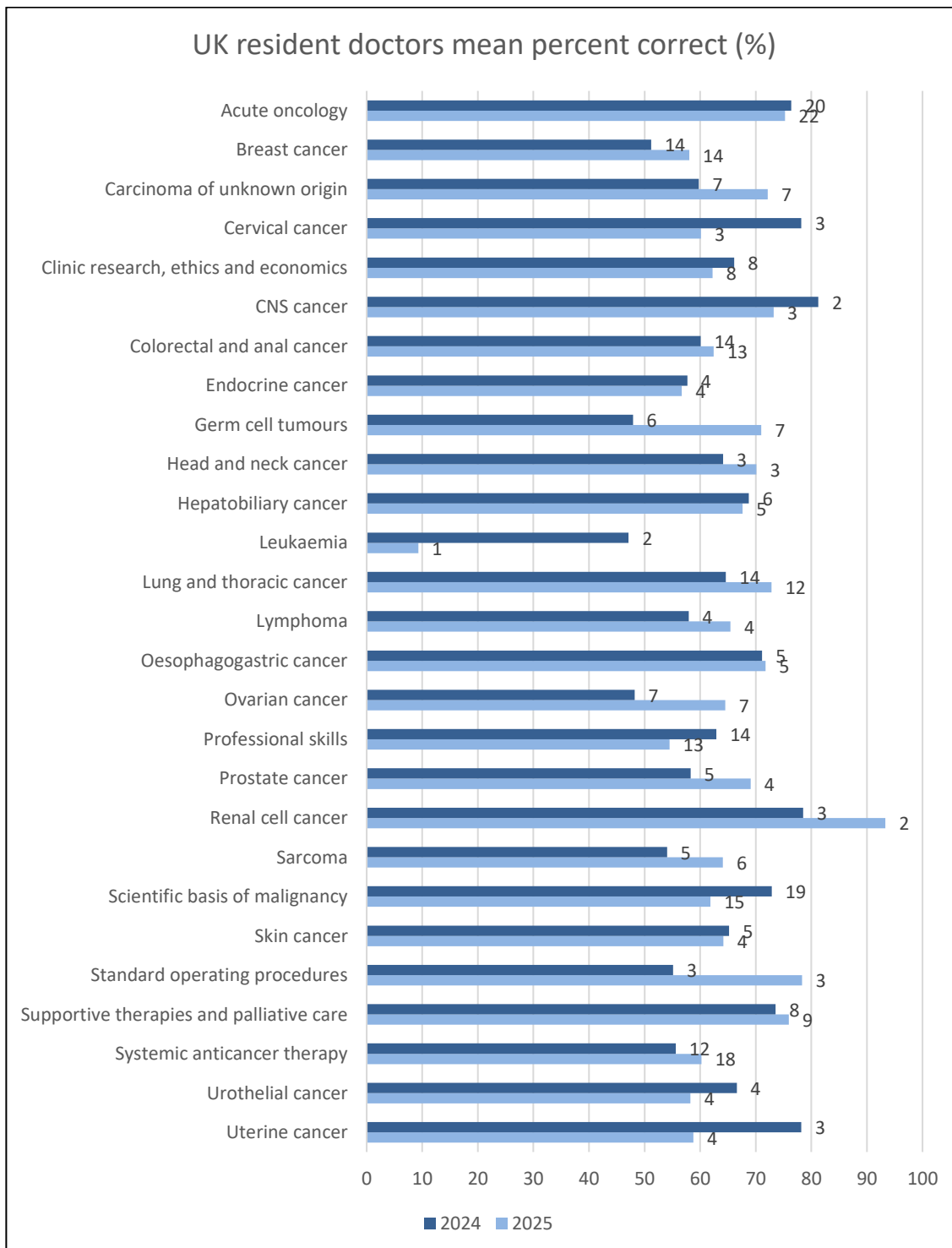
In 2025 ST5 UK resident doctors had the highest sitting number (40) and a pass rate of 85%. The pass rate for all UK resident doctors was 74.2% and 58.3% for all candidates.



The numbers at the top of the bars are the number of resident doctors sitting.

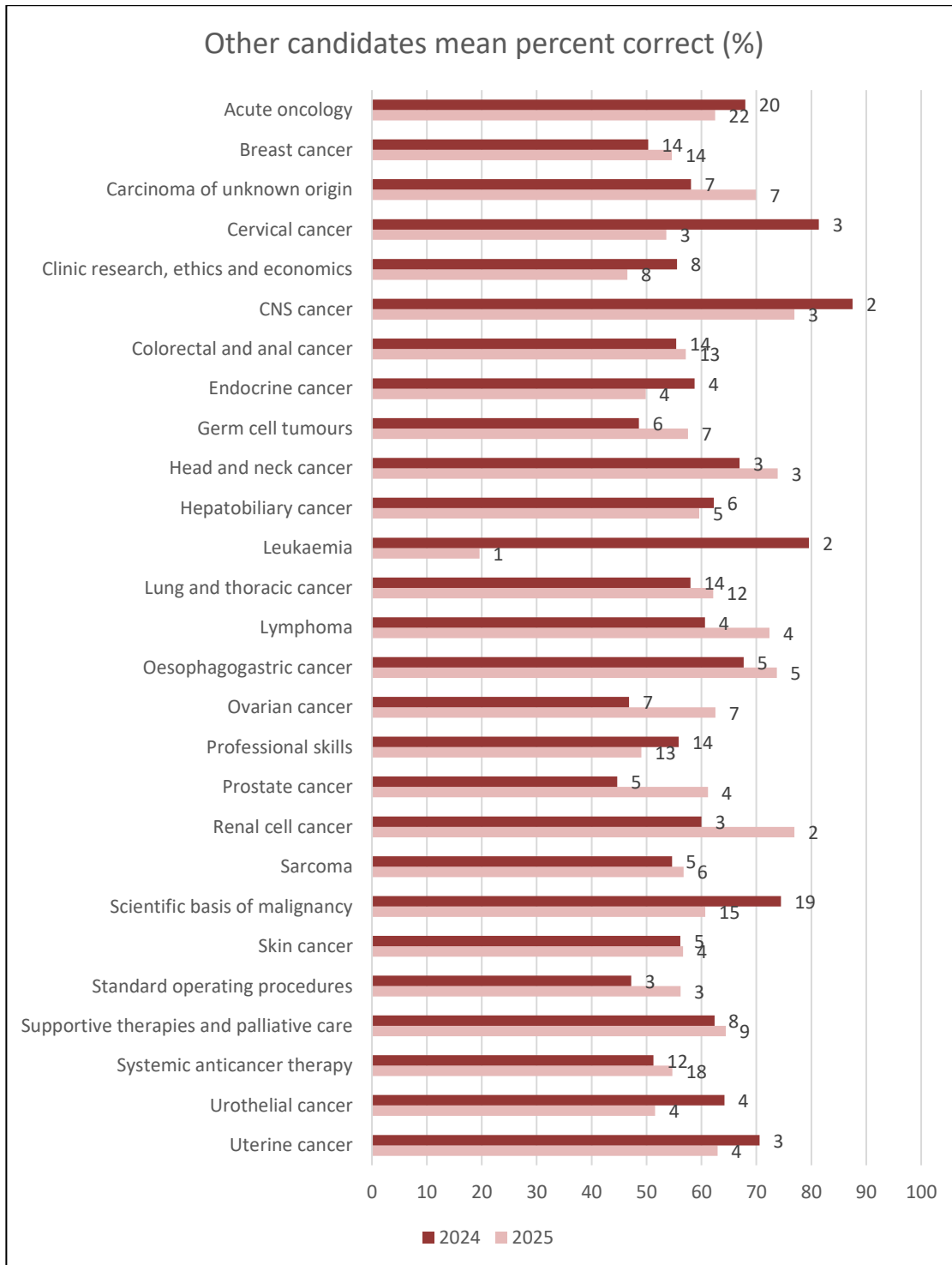
Topic performance

In 2025 UK resident doctors had their highest percentage of correct answers in Renal cell cancer (93.3%) and their lowest in Leukaemia (9.3%).

In 2025 Other candidates had their highest percentage of correct answers in Renal cell cancer (76.9%) and their lowest in Leukaemia (19.6%).
